Wednesday Men's Club Play

Fee Breakdown and Payouts

The following breakdown will be used for the 2019/2020 Men's Club Golfing Season. It will be used on a trial basis for the last 2 weeks of October and if needed, tweaked here and there and put into play starting the first Wednesday of November. The objective is to create a competitive environment that is fair for golfers of all abilities. Our course is fairly unique as far as its challenges and potential for scoring, especially for the higher handicap players.

Breakdown of Fees

Entry Fee: \$20

Men's Club	\$2	Collected and given to Men's Club
Progressive Skin (Flighted)	\$1	Cash Payout within Flight
Individual Low Net (Flighted)	\$5	Cash Payout within Flight
Individual Net Skins (Flighted)	\$5	Cash Payout within Flight
Team Blind Draw	\$5	Book Credit Payout
Closest to the Pin	\$2	Cash Payout with a max payout of \$15

Two Flights will be created each week using course handicap. Participants will compete for Skins and Low Net within their respective flights. Doing this allows us to remove the handicap limits previously put in place for skins. **Full handicap will be given to each participant for these events.**

The Progressive Skin will be determined using the skins winners for each day. If there are an even number of skins won in the flight, the money will carry over to the next week. If there are an odd number of skins won, a random number will be drawn by the golf shop and the last skin won before that hole will be the winner of the progressive skin.

The Closest to the Pins will be available on each par 3. Maximum payout will be capped at \$15 with any remaining funds to be allocated to the Men's Club.

The Blind Draw will be determined once every player has gone out. Teams and format will be determined based on that total number. Payout will be issued in the form of credit that will be available for golf shop and restaurant purchases. You may not use credits for rounds of golf, membership dues or any form of play pass. Credits will have an expiration that will coincide with the closure of the golf course for overseeding.

The Men's Club is vital to the continued growth of the Wickenburg Golf Club and routinely donates money for projects that improve the golf course and the operation. The \$2 fee and the money collected from dues enables the Men's Club to continue the tradition of supporting important improvement projects. The weekly play on Wednesday is designed to mix up players and allow newcomers the chance to meet new players. This is important, not only to the business, but also to the future of our Men's Club. Let's hope for a successful year for the Wickenburg Men's Golf Association.
